Love	A great feeling of affection towards someone or something.
Difference	A point or way in which people or things are dissimilar.
Respect	A feeling of deep admiration for someone or something elicited by their abilities, qualities or achievements.
Joys	A feeling of great pleasure and happiness.
Sorrows	A feeling of distress or sadness caused by loss or disappointment.
Community	A group of people living in the same place.
Holy Family	Christ as a child with Mary and Joseph.
