ESSENTIAL VOCABULARY

Word	Definition
Loss	The fact or process of losing something or someone.
Death	the action or fact of dying or being killed; the end of the life of a person or organism.
Change	Make or become different.
Growth	The process of increasing in size.
Ash Wednesday	The first day of Lent marked by services of penitence.
Lent	The period preceding Easter, which is devoted to fasting, abstinence, penitence and alms giving.
Holy Week	The week before Easter, beginning on Palm Sunday.
The Triduum	A period of 2 days observance – Maundy Thursday, Good Friday & Holy Saturday.
Easter Vigil	The ceremonies of Holy Saturday & the most solemn memorial of the liturgical year. Consists of four parts; the service of light, Liturgy of the Word, Liturgy of Baptism and Liturgy of the Eucharist.
Resurrection	The rising of Christ from the dead.

The love and care of people

What I will learn

Make links to show how feelings and beliefs about what makes, and breaks friendship and unity affects their behaviour and that of others.

Ask and respond to questions about their own and others' experiences and feelings about friendship and unity.

Compare their own and other people's ideas about questions concerning friendship.

Make links between scripture and the Eucharist. Use a developing religious vocabulary to **give reasons** for the actions and symbols of the Communion Rite.

Give reasons why Christians gather together in 'communion' and receive 'Holy Communion'.

Show how their own and others' decisions about friendships are informed by beliefs and values.

Show understanding of the links between a range of Scripture texts and some parts of the Mass which express communion with Jesus and the feelings that communion with others brings.

Use religious terms to **show an understanding** of different aspects of the Eucharist.

Show understanding of how belief in Jesus Christ, the uniting presence in Holy Communion, shapes the lives of Christians.

The Church's seasons of Lent, Holy week and Easter; the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus led to new life
