ESSENTIAL VOCABULARY

Word	Definition
Eucharist	The Christian sacrament commemorating the Last Supper, in which bread and wine are consecrated and consumed.
Communion	The service of Christian worship at which bread and wine are consecrated and shared.
Community	A group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common.
Unity	The state of being united or joined as a whole.
Friendship	The emotions or conduct of friends; the state of being friends.
nourish	Provide with the food or other substances necessary for growth, health and good condition.

Eucharist - Relating

What nourishes and what spoils friendship and unity.

What I will learn

Make links to show how feelings and beliefs about what makes, and breaks friendship and unity affects their behaviour and that of others.

Ask and respond to questions about their own and others' experiences and feelings about friendship and unity.

Compare their own and other people's ideas about questions concerning friendship.

Make links between scripture and the Eucharist. Use a developing religious vocabulary to **give reasons** for the actions and symbols of the Communion Rite.

Give reasons why Christians gather together in 'communion' and receive 'Holy Communion'.

Show how their own and others' decisions about friendships are informed by beliefs and values.

Show understanding of the links between a range of Scripture texts and some parts of the Mass which express communion with Jesus and the feelings that communion with others brings.

Use religious terms to **show an understanding** of different aspects of the Eucharist.

Show understanding of how belief in Jesus Christ, the uniting presence in Holy Communion, shapes the lives of Christians.
