 - That the Christian Bible is split into two parts, the Old Testament, and the New Testament.

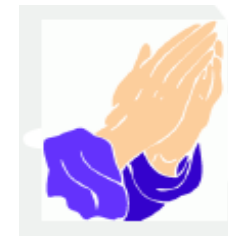
