



Curriculum Information - Year 5

Autumn Term 2

English	In English, we will have a poetry focus based on the text "Where the Poppies Now Grow". Children will create their own 5 lined cinquain poem about remembrance. Children will learn about famous women scientists such as Mary Anning or Marie Curie and write a biography about their life and achievements. We will study narrative by looking at the text The adventures of Odysseus by Hugh Lupton, Daniel Morden and Christiana Balit. The children will write a mythical adventure story to include the setting, character and dialogue. Children will develop their fluency and comprehension during regular guided reading sessions.
